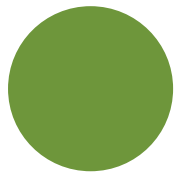
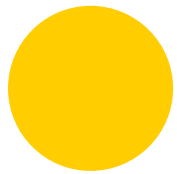


Where do I go for care?



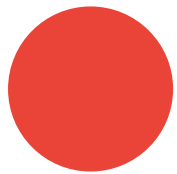
Primary Care is for non-urgent symptoms

such as eczema, ongoing back pain, allergies, irregular periods, and fatigue, plus routine check-ups, reproductive health care, medication management, referrals for specialty care, etc. **Cost: \$**



Urgent Care is for urgent symptoms

such as minor injuries, moderate cold/flu symptoms, skin infections, urinary symptoms, mild allergic reactions, etc. **Cost: \$\$**



Emergency Departments are for critical situations

that threaten loss of your life or limbs such as chest pain, severe head trauma, loss of consciousness, severe abdominal pain, seizures, severe broken bones, severe cuts and burns, etc. **Cost: \$\$\$**
